

CHILD PROTECTION POLICY STATEMENT

Bath judo club is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for children and young people.

We do this by:

- 1. Recognising that all children have the right to freedom from abuse.
- 2. Ensuring that all our volunteers and staff are carefully selected and accept responsibility for helping to prevent the abuse of children in their care.
- 3. Responding swiftly and appropriately to all suspicions or allegations of abuse, and providing parents and children with the opportunity to voice any concerns they may have.
- 4. Appointing a Child Protection Officer who will take specific responsibility for child protection and act as the main point of contact for parents, children and outside agencies.
- 5. Ensuring access to confidential information is restricted to the Child Protection Officer or the appropriate external authorities.
- 6. Reviewing the effectiveness of our Child Protection Policy and activities annually.
